



The Deep, one of the most spectacular aquariums in the world is located in Hull, East Yorkshire. This award winning visitor attraction is home to over 3,500 fish, including spectacular sharks and rays.

The dramatic building which overlooks the Humber Estuary was designed by Sir Terry Farrell and is only a few minutes walk from Hull Marina and the museums quarter. The Deep is operated as a charity, dedicated to increasing enjoyment and understanding of the world's oceans.

This marine based visitor attraction opened its' doors in March 2002 and includes provision for research and learner facilities and an associated business centre.

The building exploits the landscape on which it is built and was inspired by natural geological land formations and marks a unique entry point to Kingston upon Hull.
